The Summer School, therefore, will offer the good opportunity to those who wishes to learn further on the spot to improve language skills in the local circumstances.

Fukuoka Univ. students pitch in with the program activities for assistance, that will be a wonderful opportunity for the participating students to practice and use the language skills in a real setting as well as to make local friends through associating with their Japanese counterparts.

We look forward to having the aspirant students join the summer experience of learning at Fukuoka Univ. campus.

Quota:	20 participants (In case of less than 10 applicants, the program shall be called off.)
Eligibility:	Undergraduate students currently enrolled in university/college
Prerequisite:	Japanese language proficiency equivalent to the N3 ~N2 level in Japanese Language Proficiency Test
Fees:	JPY 100,000 (including program fees and accommodation)
Application Deadline:	May 7(Tuesday)
Payment Deadline:	May 23(Thursday)

Application Procedures:

Required materials for application are

2. A copy of "Certificate of Proficiency (which indicates his/her having passed the test) "of the N3 level or the N2 level in Japanese Language Proficiency Test
3. A certificate of enrollment issued by your university/college
4. A copy of overseas traveler's insurance which is valid for the period of the Summer School *2
*2 You are required to join in the home country before departing their own health and accident insurance covering for the period of Summer School in Fukuoka.
5. A copy of passport (the biographical page)

*3 Please note that the application (as an interim registration) is reserved on a first-come- first-served basis.
We closes the list earlier, even before application deadline of May 7, upon the application's reaching the quota(20).

The admission will be notified to the applicants by email. The applicant who received the notification, that includes the bank information for wire transfer of fees, must make a payment by wire transfer **before May 23 (Thursday)**.

Securing the place in the program & accommodation and the application for the Summer School will be confirmed with the applicant's full payment of the fees (JPY 100,000), and then the letter of acceptance will be sent to him/her.

Cancellation Policy :

For the cancellation received by us at Center for International Programs Office until June 20(Thursday), the entire fees will be refunded. If you withdraw for the period from June 21(Friday) to June 25(Tuesday), 50% of the fees will be funded. No refund will be given after June 26(Wednesday) under any circumstances.

Visa:

It is the applicant's responsibility to make visa application and obtain the valid visa at the Japanese embassy/ consulate office. Please ask the nearest Japanese embassy/consulate in the home country for the accurate information and for their advice regarding the visa procedures.

Program Information:

- Japanese language : 12 lectures (a lecture = 1.5 hours)
- Japanese culture : "tea ceremony" experience
- Field trip :
 1. Visit to the notable sights in Fukuoka(Fukuoka Tower, Fukuoka Yahoo Dome Stadium, Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine, Kyushu National Museum)
 2. Sightseeing in the city including viewing "Kazariyama"^{*4} (Tenjin, Canal City Hakata which is a shopping complex comprising a variety of business and leisure facilities, Hakata Station area)
 - ^{*4} 8-meter-tall decorated floats which are dressed by the Hakata Doll masters, which are displayed in a variety of sites during Hakata Gion Yamakasa Festival celebrated from July 1-15 in Hakata area of the city
 3. Bus trip to Nagasaki(visit to Atomic Bomb Memorial Museum, Peace Park and Dejima)

Accommodation:

The participating students are accommodated in Fukuoka Univ. Seminar House which is located close to the center of the city. It takes less than 10 min. by subway to the campus from the House. In the House, 3 students share the room.
